

Guidance to Help You Enjoy the Gardens Safely

DO

- Wear appropriate footwear and keep to the paths where possible
- Look out for trip hazards e.g. tree roots, stumps, ivy, low branches
- Take care in wet conditions when certain areas could be slippery
- Be aware that there may be moving vehicles and grounds maintenance equipment being operated around the site
- Check the website for health and safety advice updates (<https://thwaite-gardens.hull.ac.uk/health-and-safety/>)
- Wash your hand before eating or drinking

DO NOT

- Pick flowers, foliage or cut branches unless you have had permission (some plants may be poisonous or act as irritants)

- Climb trees or walls
- Walk on the flower beds
- Leave any litter
